Dear Doctor,

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Distinguished Fellow of the American College of Osteopathic Emergency Physicians (FACOEP *Dist.*). This new designation was approved by the Board of Directors of the College in 2007 and refined by the Fellowship Committee and Board during the latter part of 2009.

To qualify for this award, applicants must be nominated by other Fellows or Distinguished Fellows. The criteria for awarding the Honorary Title of Distinguished Fellow of the American College of Osteopathic Emergency Physicians are as follows:

- Involved in the active practice of emergency medicine, EMS, disaster medicine, pediatric emergency medicine or medical toxicology
- Involved on committees, boards, or other activities of either ACOEP, AOBEM or AOA
- Prior or current involvement in professional organizations on an international, national, state or local level that concern emergency medicine, EMS/disaster management, pediatric emergency medicine or medical toxicology.
- Involved in significant ongoing research contributions to the specialty of emergency medicine or any of the above subspecialty areas of emergency medicine.
- Involved in the development of a clinical training program as the program director, (initial or continuing position)
- Service to the profession that has achieved national, state, or regional recognition.
- Recognition or awards for excellence in emergency medicine (or its subspecialty areas) from local, state, and national organizations

Criteria for selection to this title will be (1) current status as a Fellow of the American College of Osteopathic Emergency Physicians (FACOEP) for a minimum of 10 years and (2) a letter of nomination outlining the reason for this designation. All applications must contain a current CV of the Nominee. Deadlines for nomination to this award will be the same as nominations to the title of Fellow (March 1). The Fellowship and Nominations Committee will consider nominations annually at its spring meeting and recommendations will be submitted to the Board of Directors for final approval. Successful candidates must receive unanimous approval of the ACOEP Board of Directors. Distinguished Fellows of the ACOEP are authorized to use the designation FACOEP (*Dist.*) as long as they remain as members in good standing of the ACOEP.

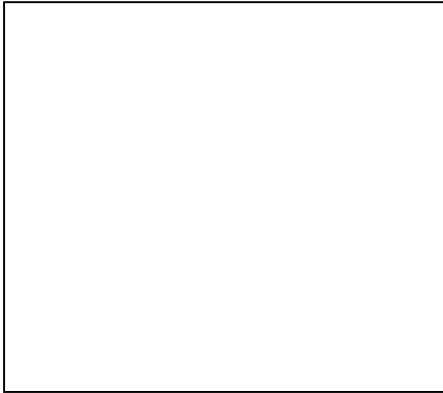
